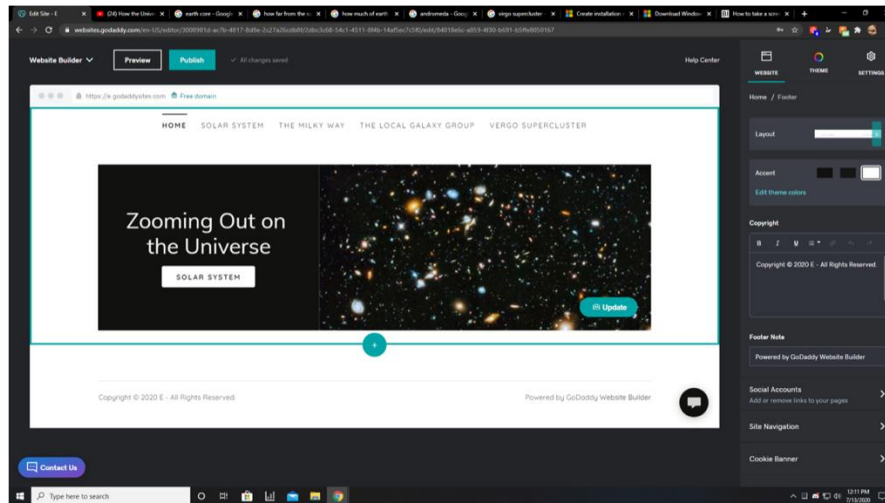


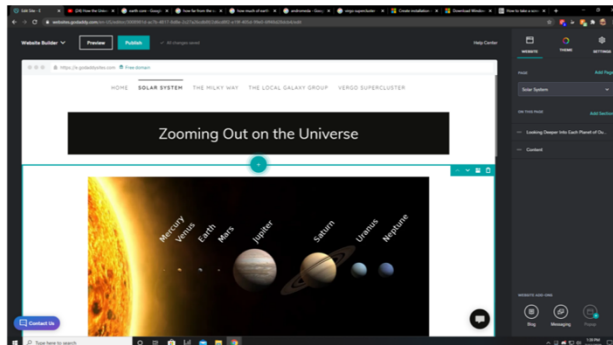

Project Work:

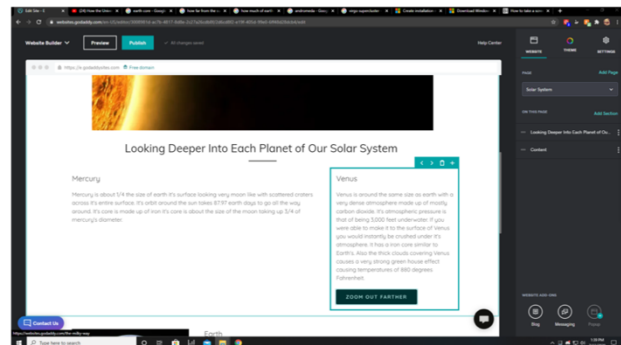

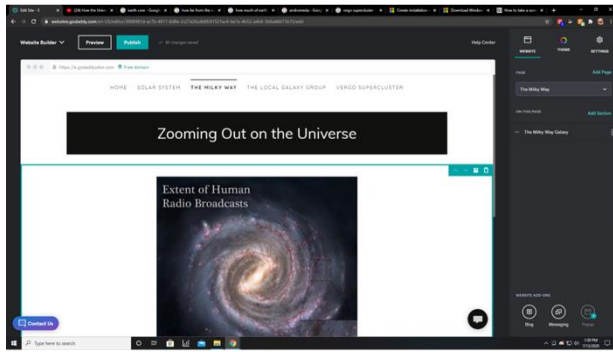

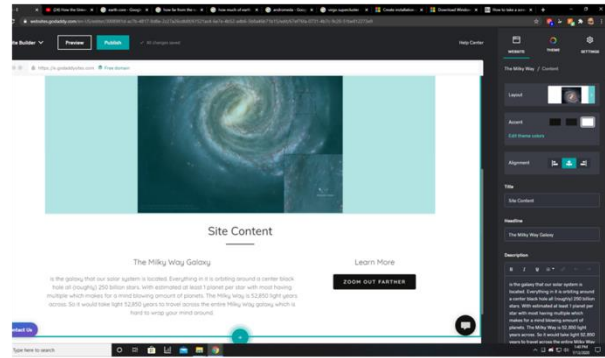
Page 2 -- Top



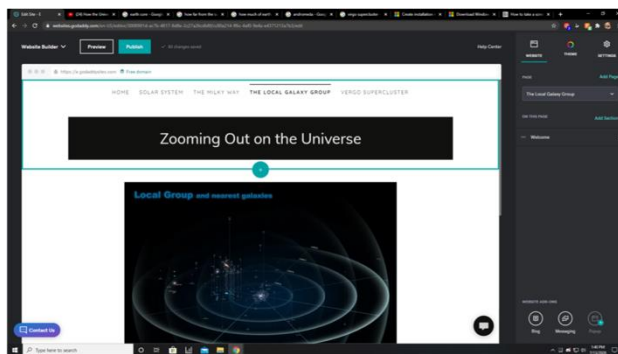
Page 2 -- Bottom



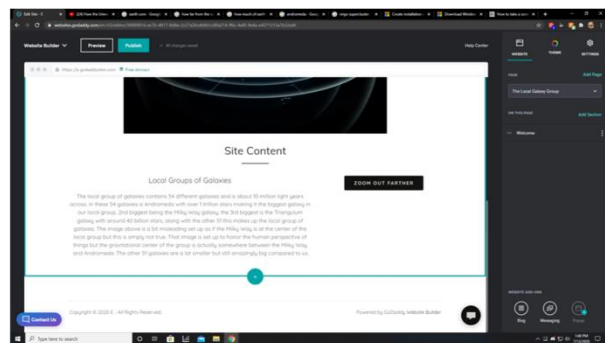
Page 3 -- Top



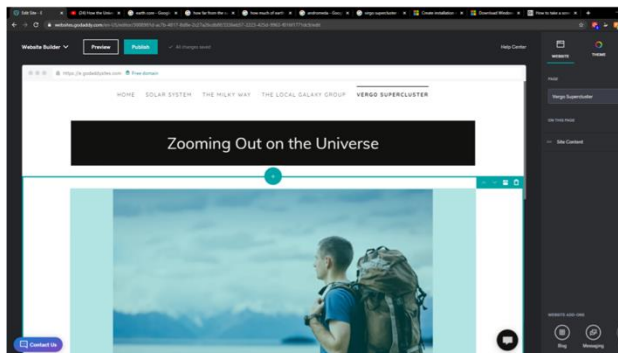
Page 3 -- Bottom



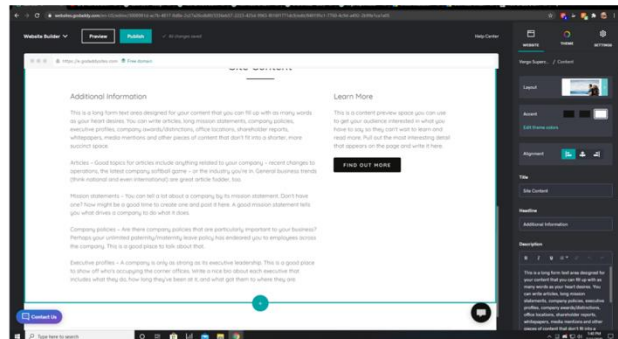
Page 4 -- Top
